



## EMERGENCY FIRST AID - STANDARD



The course Provide an Emergency First Aid Response in an Education and Care Setting is relevant to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting.

**Course Code:** HLTAID004

**Course Currency Status:** Current

**VET Prerequisite:** No VET prerequisites required

**Mode of Delivery:** Pre-learning and face to face classroom

**Duration:** Up to 8 hours of pre-course reading and E-learning Assessment, plus 9 hours face to face training in a classroom environment

**Course Title:** Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting.

**Assessment:** Written, practical and scenario-based assessment

**Entry Requirements:** Prior to commencing face to face training you will be required to successfully complete a short Knowledge Verification & Language, Literacy and Numeracy Questionnaire

**Minimum Age Requirement:** 14 Years

**Certificate Valid:** 36 Months from the date of course completion

### Course Content:

The course will provide students with skills and knowledge in the following areas:

- Recognise an emergency situation
- Identify, assess and minimise immediate hazards to health and safety of self and others
- Assess the casualty and recognise the need for first aid response
- Assess the situation and seek assistance from emergency response services
- Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in accordance with Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines
- Provide first aid in accordance with established first aid principles
- Ensure casualty feels safe, secure and supported
- Obtain consent from casualty, caregiver, registered medical practitioners or medical emergency services where possible
- Use available resources and equipment to make the casualty as comfortable as possible
- Operate first aid equipment according to manufacturer's instructions
- Monitor the casualty's condition and respond in accordance with first aid principles
- Accurately convey details of the incident to emergency response services
- Report details of incident to supervisor
- Complete relevant workplace documentation, including incident report form
- Report details of incidents involving babies and children to parents and/or caregivers
- Follow workplace procedures to report serious incidents to the regulatory authority
- Maintain confidentiality of records and information in line with statutory and/or organisational policies
- Recognise the possible psychological impacts on self, other rescuers and children
- Talk with children about their emotions and responses to events
- Participate in debriefing with supervisor

**Certificate Issued:** Students who successfully complete all the training and assessment requirements will receive within 48 hours an electronic Statement of Attainment in HLTAID001 – Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation, HLTAID002 – Provide basic emergency life support, HLTAID003 - Provide first aid and HLTAID004- Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting.

### Who Can Attend?

This course is for those with existing first aid experience or for Students who are new to first aid and comfortable learning in a blended delivery setting

### Factor to Consider:

Students attending course will be required to demonstrate their physical ability to perform 2 x 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on an adult and child manikin placed on the floor to meet the performance criteria for assessment.
